Focus areas for 2023 - 2024



Key governance focus areas for the FNZSS

- ▶ Implementing the new committee structure
- ▶ Clearly defining the role and expectations of the Regional Representatives and the separation between governance and management
- ▶ Ensuring that appropriate policies and guidelines are in-place, as required by law and/or good governance
- ▶ Align FNZSS Constitution with the new Incorporated Societies Act 2022
- ▶ Review and update the memorandum of understanding between the FNZSS and Member Societies.

Key operational focus areas for the FNZSS

- Continuing to consult with and engage Member Societies in material matters
- Raising national awareness about SeniorNet
- Supporting and encouraging the use of SeniorHangouts v2.0
- Implementing a 'Hosts and Hubs' framework to support disenfranchised seniors
- Supporting Learning Centres:
 - Develop boilerplate templates to support member and tutor recruitment
 - Develop advice and guidance for Learning Centres, regarding:
 - changes required by the Incorporated Societies Act 2022
 - Policies they should have in place, e.g. Health & Safety
- Managing relationships with current sponsors and seeking new (appropriate) sponsors
- Identifying appropriate organisations for SeniorNet to partner or align with
- Negotiating group insurance cover and review on-charges to Member Societies
